Dietary Needs

Golden Bell is willing to accommodate gluten-free, dairy-free, and vegetarian dietary needs. There is an added cost for these meals. On your student's registration form, there will be a spot to indicate any dietary needs. Golden Bell asks us to bring food for any extreme peanut allergy participants. Medical

UC Health Pikes Peak Regional Hospital is the closest medical facility (16420 US-24, Woodland Park, CO 80863) at 9 miles away.

Rooms/Ratios/Bedding

The room sizes at Golden Bell vary from 6-12 person rooms. The goal is to have a ratio of 1 leader for every 5-7 students. Leaders and students do not share a bed. Boys and girls will have separate sleeping areas and students will not be allowed to enter rooms of the opposite sex. Sleeping bags, pillows, and bedding need to be brought.
