## Dietary Needs

Golden Bell is willing to accommodate gluten-free, dairy-free, and vegetarian dietary needs. There is an added cost for these meals. On your student's registration form, there will be a spot to indicate any dietary needs. Golden Bell asks us to bring food for any extreme peanut allergy participants. You may contact Golden Bell directly with specific needs and questions.

## Medical

There will be a Registered Nurse at the retreat center for the entirety of the weekend. In the event of an unexpected accident, a qualified medical professional will tend to your child's needs. UC Health Pikes Peak Regional Hospital is the closest medical facility (16420 US-24, Woodland Park, CO 80863) at 9 miles away.

## Rooms/Ratios/Bedding

The room sizes at Golden Bell vary from 6-12 person rooms. The goal is to have a ratio of 1 leader for every 5-7 students. Leaders and students do not share a bed. Boys and girls will have separate sleeping areas and students will not be allowed to enter rooms of the opposite sex. Sleeping bags, pillows, and bedding need to be brought.

## Money

- Snacks/Souvenirs – Golden Bell has a souvenir shop and a snack shop at the retreat center. The snack shop will be open throughout the weekend for students to make purchases.
- T-Shirts – We will have a limited number of shirts available at the retreat for \$15. The selection will be limited since you can preorder shirts.
