A TIME AND SEASON

In the book of Ecclesiastes, Solomon reminds us that there is a time and season for everything.

“There is an appointed time for everything. And there is a time for every event under heaven— A time to give birth and a time to die; A time to plant and a time to uproot what is planted. A time to kill and a time to heal; A time to tear down and a time to build up.” (Ecclesiastes 3:1–3)

The interval between one appointed time or season and another necessarily brings with it change. But just as our Sovereign Lord appoints the various times and seasons of our lives, even so He graciously promises to walk beside us through these epochs of change (Deut. 31:6; Matt. 28:20; Heb. 13:5).

Our church family has been walking together through just such a season of change. After outgrowing our facility, our church decided to sell its building and relocate to a larger facility that could better accommodate present ministry and future growth. So in 2022 we sold our building to another gospel preaching church in town and we purchased a call center and warehouse and began the process of renovating it to suit our purposes. In this increasingly expensive real estate and construction market, we found that buying an existing commercial building and repurposing it was significantly less expensive than a new build.

In my recent studies, I have learned that the early church did something very similar. In the first century, many churches met in large, private homes, sometimes even purchasing these large homes, and repurposing them for the weekly meeting of the church. These were called *domus ecclesiae*, or “house churches.” In the third century, before the era of Constantine and the state-sponsored building of many purpose-designed church buildings and cathedrals (*basilica ecclesiae*), Christians frequently repurposed existing warehouses and other large commercial buildings and transformed them into churches, called *aula ecclesiae*, or “church halls.”

We also got a new name. Anticipating an imminent move, we officially changed our name from the geographically-focused name of Austin Bluffs Evangelical Free Church to the more gospel-centered name of Cross & Crown Church. We love this new name because it vividly illustrates and summarizes the whole gospel message using two paradoxical images that represent Christ’s suffering and glory. The images of the cross and the crown also represent our own present suffering and hope of future glory as well.

There was much planning and preparation that went into the actual move, especially since it was going to be over the holidays. Our final Sunday morning worship service at our old campus was on Christmas Day 2022 and our first Sunday morning worship service at our new building was on New Year’s Day 2023. A new name, a new location, a new building, and all within the space of about a year. Whew! That’s a lot of change.

Yet in the midst of all of this change, there’s much that didn’t change. Although we found ourselves in a new location and in a new building, and although much around us seemed so new and unfamiliar, we realized that the things that really matter hadn’t changed at all.

The loving community of our church family did not change. The gospel-centered ministry and strong doctrinal commitments of our ministry and leadership hadn’t changed. The desire to glorify God and exalt Jesus Christ in our worship gatherings through song, sacrament, and the preaching of the Word of God hadn’t changed. And most assuredly, God and His promise to walk with us through these sometimes-tumultuous seasons hadn’t changed (Malachi 3:6; James 1:17). May we all readily give thanks to God for His faithfulness to lead us through each season of change He ordains for us.

A New Home, Opportunity, and Ministry!

Faith Church in Fort Collins, Colorado is launching a new ministry to the thousands of refugees pouring into Nante, France. The ministry, called Refugee Oasis, will provide a place for individuals and teams from the United States to serve refugees from the Middle East and North Africa through short term trips, internships-- including gap years, as well as long term opportunities.

Refugee Oasis resulted from a simple conversation between Brad Jensen (former lead pastor at Faith Church) and his wife Thea. When Thea asked, "You don't think it's supposed to be us, do you?" it was mostly meant to be a rhetorical question, and if Brad did choose to respond, he was supposed to say, "What? Of course not." Thea asked this question of Brad as they talked over outreach to refugees in Nantes, France after spending a week there with a short-term team from Faith Church in October. During their days in Nantes, they had no inkling that God was going to move them to France. Brad and Thea had enjoyed new experiences with the team members and had been fascinated to meet refugees from multiple countries. The team had their eyes opened to God's work in moving masses of people out of the Middle East and North Africa to Europe where the Gospel is accessible to them. During that week, Brad spent the evenings searching the internet for ministries effectively reaching refugees and only found a few. Somebody needed to do something! This is a dangerous thing to say, and to pray. The result is that Faith Church is establishing a place of welcome and help to refugees in Nantes, France.

We have all heard for years about refugees and have prayed for them, but of course it is very different to sit down at a table surrounded by refugees from multiple countries and look at their faces and hear their stories. Refugees are forced to figure out the logistics of moving to another country under dangerous circumstances and by unsafe routes with no sure idea of where they will end up. And what will they do when they get there?

There are millions of refugees coming to Western Europe. During the time Faith's short-term team was in Nantes, they saw simple but powerful ways to help. Refugees are looking for language classes so they can establish new lives in a new country. They need help with visas and paperwork. And they are seeking community, a place of welcome. We can provide that help with the love of Jesus. The plan is to provide a path for American and French Christians to help refugees and share Jesus with them: for Americans-- short-term trips, internships, long-term commitments, and for the French--events and programming they can step into.

Brad and Thea plan to move to Nantes at the beginning of June. The first step is to open a refugee community center. A short-term team from Faith will come in July along with several individuals over the summer and fall. This ministry is open to all of the Evangelical Free churches in the district, creating a way to meet, love, and share Jesus with refugees coming out of countries that have long been closed to the gospel.

A gladiator, sasquatch, and a youth leader go to a retreat...

For the first full weekend in February, 275 middle and high school students along with youth leaders and volunteer leaders attended our Rocky Mountain District youth retreat at Golden Bell Camp near Divide, CO. There were eight churches from Wyoming and Colorado who ascended to 10,000 feet for this new iteration of the youth retreat. In the past, we had two different retreats separating middle and high school, but the post-covid world we live in required us to shift to a new strategy to better serve the churches in our district.

This year's theme was called "The Door," looking at Jesus in John 10 where He told the Pharisees, "I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and go in and out and find pasture." During our first session on Friday night, we asked students where they were with Jesus. Our speaker then invited them to find life with God by walking through the door that is Jesus. From there, students learned what it means to live on that side of the door and abide in Him.

I am grateful for these intentional times away with our students even if it is just a weekend. Gathering large groups of students together to sing praises to God, play games, hear biblically based teaching, and grow in their relationship with God and others will have ripple effects for the rest of the school year and beyond. Friendships were formed and strengthened, and the students were challenged to be honest about their relationship with Jesus. I pray for the Holy Spirit's continued movement and growth in all who attended. We strive to raise disciples of Jesus who will live for Him and make disciples who will do the same.

Every youth retreat results in crazy and fun memories! Some of my favorite memories include over 30 middle school students getting on tubes and forming the longest sledding train I have ever seen go down a sledding hill! I'll also remember the impromptu National Anthem that occurred before the high school dodgeball championship along with a "fly by" thanks to some of the students. Watching students in bumper cars ignore the game so they could ram their volunteer leaders in Whirly-Ball was a sight to see. I laugh when I remember a group of students playing tug of war with a stuffed Shaun the Sheep while trying to keep it from a student "wolf" which resulted in Shaun's head coming off. The Outer Realm gladiator games that had middle school students chanting like Yetis, Sasquatches, and Loch Ness Monsters is a sight to behold.

The most memorable part was how God worked in hearts! I'll remember the names written in all different colors with different handwriting on the back of a gate that was built for this series. The names represented students giving their life to Jesus for the first time or coming back after a time of wandering. The Holy Spirit moved in around 100 souls. I praise God for every student who had the courage to get up, walk through the gate, and write their name. I also praise God for those students who stayed seated. They are either walking faithfully with Jesus or they haven't come to faith, yet. The reason I praise God is because where else would we want any of these students to be? For 48 hours they were hearing songs of praise to God, experiencing His Church, listening to His words from the Bible, and seeing the love of God through amazing volunteer leaders. It is messy, but it is good.

Please pray for the Holy Spirit's conviction and illumination in the hearts of this generation! Pray for them to love Jesus more than anything else.

Also, thank you to those youth leaders who volunteered their time to help make this possible! I am thankful to have such a dedicated planning and execution team that makes this happen year after year. Thank you to Chris and Jake (Calvary Bible Church), Jeff (Fellowship EFC), and Matt (New Life Community Church) for your sacrifice and leadership for this "Wntr Wknd!"
